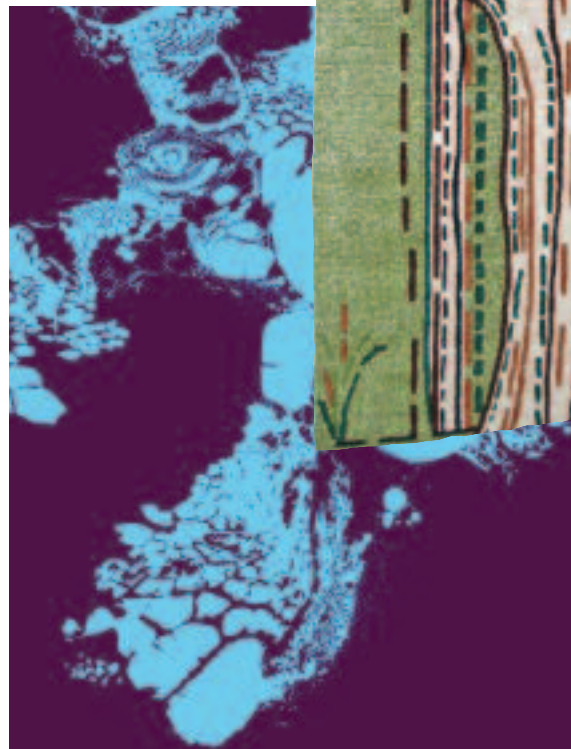

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Show and Tell

The London Design Festival may be a big event on the horizon but there are plenty of other international shows in the offing during 2010.

Over to Spain for **Hábitat Valencia** (28 September-2 October), a fair that shows off the best of Spanish design. Exhibitors this year will include textile company Tres Tintas **3**, Now Carpets, Gandia Blasco and Nanimarquina.

In London, **Revealing Evidence** at the PM Gallery, Ealing, will highlight the textile and photographic work of Shelly Goldsmith **4** and Sarah Pickering on 15 September-23 October.

The third **Comolongmo Fair** 'Experience the Magic of Nepal', offering an extensive selection of fair trade products from Nepal, will be at London's Spitalfields Market on Saturday 30 October. Comolongmo was established to promote Nepalese fair trade products and the rugs produced by the Kumbeshwar Technical School (founded in 1983 for socially and economically deprived pupils, to help alleviate poverty). The organisation holds a competition each year for school children to design a carpet. The three winning entries are made into rugs and will shown at the fair **2**.

Norfolk-based fabric company St. Jude's will be holding an exhibition entitled **St. Jude's in the City** showing their artist designed fabrics and limited edition prints at London's Bankside Gallery on 9-21 November **5**.

A selling exhibition of new **Wissa Wassef tapestries** from the Ramses Wissa Wassef Art Centre, Cairo, will be on at 3 Bedfordbury, Covent Garden, on 24 November-5 December **1**.



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
